I live at 818 N. 15th, in Waco, Texas.

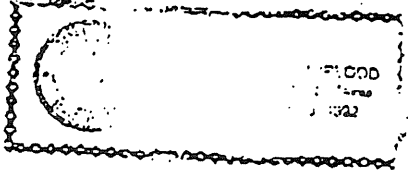
Two or three weeks before the trial of Calvin

me and put me in jail. He told me he had enough
evidence to put Capital Murder on me. He promised me
immunity if I would testify that I was with Calvin
and Joe Sidney Williams when they burglarized the house
and killed Juanita White. This was not true and I
told him that I would not testify to it. Joe Layman,
an attorney, was appointed for me and I was released that
same day.

The day Waymond Dotson testified in Calvin's trial, Karen
and I bought me, Waymond, Booker Sterling, Fate Dotson, Rene
Dosier, ~~and~~ Geraldine Douglas, and Alfredo Dosier hamburgers
and French fries for lunch. Before they brought the
food in Fate Dotson told me that the reason he testified
that he saw with Calvin and Joe Sidney Williams was that
Truman Simons told him to. He had told Simons that I really
didn't have anything to do with it, but he did what
Truman Simons told him to do.

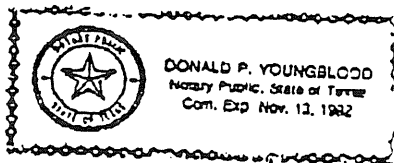
STATEMENT OF: Angela Milos

"My name is William Donnell Jackson. I am 21 years of age, and live at 1909B Morrow, in the city of Waco, Texas. I have personal knowledge of the matters set forth in this affidavit.

^{7/15/87} I was at the welfare office in Waco, Texas, on December 8, 1987. While there I had a conversation with a person known to me as, and who I know as Alberta Degrate. She stated to me that ~~she was in~~ a hurry because she had to testify in the case of The State of Texas vs. Calvin Edward Washington. I told her that she did not even know Calvin Washington. She said she did not know him but she was going to have to testify anyway. She further told me that "she had a case on her" and that she had to testify because of that. Due to the way she talked, and her actions which I observed, I took her statement to mean that she had made an arrangement with the prosecution to testify in return for favorable action in the case pending against her. I was in the 54th District Court on December 8, 1987, and observed Alberta Degrate testify under oath. After she completed testifying, I believed that she was not telling the

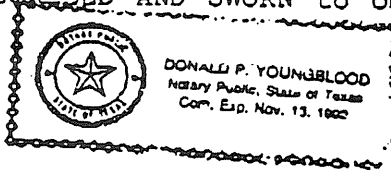
