He seemed very withdrawn, not easy to build any kind of relationship with trust. That came out period of 7 months.

I think he wanted to get along with his dad. I think he talked at length with Dr about it. I think he knows more than will ever know seemed to be a lack of any real concern. No closeness no real mother/son relationship.

He lived at mother's house 1st yr & dealt with him. He didn't run with anyone in particular. Didn't seem to have any long term relationships.

If you saw David's reaction to disagreement, you would see his 'bitch' image.

Never any animosity shown toward me. I think if David had had some family support he might have made it.

He was with Christy the entire time.

If conversation going into direction he didn't like, he'd give cold stare, threat (with Christy or brother) just like people intruding in his area.

It's not just the eyes. Coupled with stare + facial expression devoid of emotion - threatening.

Christy made me aware he was supposed to be uninvolved in Church of Satan, when David in jail on robbery case. She called one day, called, talked for 1:15. Said he was in Church of Satan.

I'd seen him 4-5 days before he was arrested. Saw his mom + brother. Went to see him in jail. Was rationalizing, wasn't accepting responsibility.

I never felt positive about David because support wasn't there. He was standing alone

Based on his subtle indications, he was prone to violence & wasn't surprised.

Christy told me David had beaten up on her (in phone conversation after he was arrested) She didn't get attention at home.

In Convicted Christy was there.

~~\_\_\_\_\_~~ went to his place, David very upset. I asked him about fact he knew too much about murders. He said people after him about murders. Wanted permit to leave town. I felt if he knew something he should get police help. Asked if I could contact police.

went to P.D - talked to Palmer, told him what had transpired, & just had some bad feelings. I told Ramon he (David) might have been involved in incident.

Thought he might have known something because of people he was involved with

21st of July - went to apt but had let him leave. David met me in parking lot, went inside. Things were okay till he & Christy got into it. David got into a 'mood' she said 'the 2 girls he had been with a night or 2 before'

13th / 16-17th Aug - on a Friday - Ronald Coleman had brought some girls to Met. Home. On Mon or Tue after incident took place I went to David's house & he told me about incident. I was upset with him - He was 25, girl 15 or 16 - we were in area of 5th St. rope. Went to Home, asked to talk to girls & get their side of story.

almond reaction: I & David were 2 years in a job. I was in intruder in his house. I was telling him something was wrong & his time -

Chief probation officer in Congress Co. called + said he needed my help. Needed someone to hit ground meaning cause had fired a gun (Congress Core).

Here, I had anywhere to 3 to 5 or 6 phone conversations. On 2 occasions I spoke with female officer. Was calling for Salinas every time.

When they had David down in cell (approx above), day after spoke with Salinas + female. Had they talked to David about Lake murder. Did knife same as one used in Lake murders. They showed me - a bunk. Salinas indicated he was gonna talk to David after I talked.

News went back + asked. Had feeling there was a pro. jealousy kind of thing.

that (when david was booked) was at least a month after the first time i had mentioned it to him...

got a call from david's mother. she was very disturbed, crying, upset. she wanted to talk to me. i went out to her residence. at time david wasn't home. she and steve were there. shwe was talking about david's nightmares, waking screaming, couldn;t sleep... about his fear that somebody was out to get him because of what he knew about the lake waco murders... at some point in conversation david walked in and the conversation closed down. i think if david hadn't walked in a lot more might have been revealed. after he got there there wasn't a lot more said.

i was never convinced that david was

actually involved in the lake murders -- until the morning i went out to talk to his mother. after i left the house that day i was convinced he not only knew about them but was involved in some way.

i went home that night and told my wife i've got the lake waco murder on my case load. told her i had already talked to PD. by that time the question i was asking myself was would whatever incormation i had, how could i convince somebody to look harder at david without violating his rights.

definatly bbefore agg. sex arrest...

2-3 days

never an indication that david was an alcoholic... did talk to him about going into a bar i knew he had been to several times... he never knew how i knew...

christy: she told of several of david's sexual abberations... his forcing her to worship satan... just ramblings of a confused, unintelligent person... it was a misguided attempt to get herself out of the picture... only real indication i ever had she might be involved... she didn't want to be involved...

he reported to me once a month... i probably stopped at david's place once a week... i think every parole officer does the same thing... he seemed to need a little more guidance and direction... try to get em work... to go to work on time... to have some kind of employment... david never had any stability

he placed himself uin the role of judge and jury on the info i gave him. and didn't check it out.
