

STATEMENT OF; Lou Ellen Booker:

I have been employed by the City of Waco for over nineteen (19) years. I started working at Fort Fisher on October 25, 1968. I am a supervisor at Fort Fisher and I work in many different areas.

I first met Jill Montgomery and Gayle Kelley when they were hired by the City of Waco in about December of 1981. Both were part time employees. They began working full time in the month of June, 1982.

Jill Montgomery was first assigned to work in the library at Fort Fisher. She was under the supervision of Linda Gladen. Jill also worked in the gift shop but did that in June of 1982.

Gayle Kelley was assigned to the gift shop area the full tenure of her employment. I was Gayle's supervisor the entire time.

I saw and talked with Gayle just about everyday she worked. I saw and talked with Jill quite frequently when she was working part time in the library and probably every day that she worked while in the gift shop. In my opinion, Gayle and Jill did look a lot a like. They are both very similar in stature, the same color of hair and similar facial features. Gayle's hair was fine while Jill's was thick and a bit longer than Gayle's. They both parted their hair in the middle. There were times that I called Gayle, Jill and Jill, Gayle.

In reference to questions about the relationship between Jill and Gayle, I think they both liked each other but there appeared

to be an underlying hostility. They would do things and talk with each other and sometimes appear to be very friendly but there was a competition between the two especially concerning Ken Franks.

Ken Franks came to Fort Fisher several times while I was there. I remember seeing him talk to both Gayle and Jill. Gayle told me that she and Ken were like brother and sister. However, Gayle's actions sometimes implied more. Jill and Ken had a boyfriend-girlfriend type relationship. I can remember Gayle talking to Ken many times on the telephone, as well as going out to lunch with him. Gayle would appear to be trying to make Jill jealous by going with Ken.

I remember seeing "Lucky" come to visit Gayle several times when I was there. I was shown a photo line-up and I picked out the person in photograph Number Three (#3) as being "Lucky". I was told his full name was Muneer Mohammad Deeb. Gayle would tell us she did not like him but she would always borrow his car or he would pick her up from work. Gayle did not always treat him very good. She would ignore him when he came to visit unless she wanted something from him.

There were times when Gayle and Jill would both be working in the giftshop area when Deeb came to visit. Deeb would talk to Gayle. I do not remember Jill talking directly to Deeb. I remember over-hearing Gayle and Jill talking about Ken Franks in the presence of Deeb. I do not remember any verbal response from Deeb but I do
